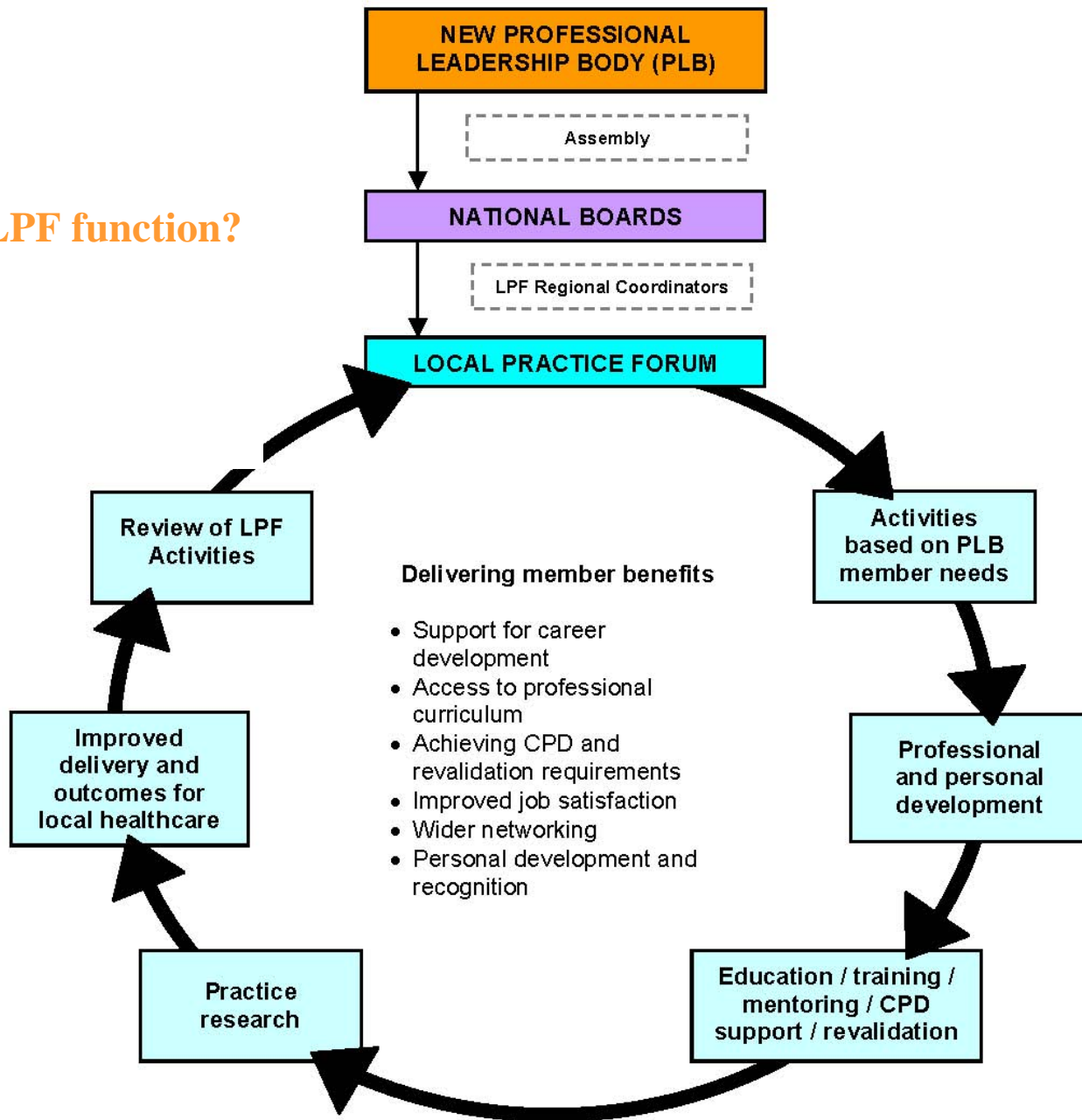

2. Regional stakeholders still being consulted – target of 40 LPFs
3. Identification of LPF transitional steering groups is critical
4. Local LPF engagement events being planned for November
5. Three LPF facilitators appointed from the 7th December

Scottish Pharmacy Board Update

5. 1 LPF facilitator appointed from 7th December
6. LPF Board Lead: Alistair Jack
