Take the exit to Dunblane and drive for half a mile on the dual carriageway before driving straight through the roundabout. The Dunblane Hydro is 200 yards on the right.</p> <p><b>from Glasgow</b></p> <p>On the M8 motorway, follow the signs for Stirling M80. Keep on the M80 and it will go onto the A80 for a few miles then revert back to the motorway. Do not take exit for Stirling, but keep on until you see the sign for Dunblane. At the roundabout, take the exit for Dunblane and continue on the dual carriageway for about half a mile until you come to a roundabout. Go straight over and at the second roundabout take the second exit. The Dunblane Hydro is 200 yards on the right.</p> <p><b>Edinburgh/Glasgow International Airport</b></p> <p>Edinburgh and Glasgow Airports are within each reach by road.</p> <p><b>By Rail - Dunblane Station</b></p> <p>The nearest train station is Dunblane which is 1.3km away, 5 minute drive or 15 minute stroll.
