Summary of an Independent Prescribing Accreditation Report

University of Bradford

1. Summary and Conclusions

As a result of the accreditation event on the 2 July 2007, the panel will recommend to the Society's Education Committee that the independent prescribing programme at the University of Bradford is accredited for a maximum period of three years.

There are no conditions associated with this report.

The accreditation panel wished to congratulate the University on the following areas of good practise which were highly commended:

- All students and their Designated Medical Practitioner were routinely visited in practise.
- A stringent and well thought through admissions process which was well aligned to the needs of the individual and the sponsoring authority
- The use of personal learning contracts which focused on the needs of individual pharmacists.

The course will not formally be accredited until the accreditation panel's recommendation has been ratified by the Society's Education Committee.

Following the above accreditation event the programme was approved for accreditation by the Society's Education Committee for a period of three years.
