REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION IN BERMUDA

In order to practise pharmacy in Bermuda a person must:

1. hold a Bachelors degree in pharmacy from the UK, USA or Canada or a qualification recognised by the Royal Pharmaceutical Society of Great Britain;
2. have completed a minimum of 6 months post graduate experience;
3. have completed a minimum of 1 month experience (after graduation) under the supervision, in Bermuda, of a registered pharmacist;
4. be a member of the Bermuda Pharmaceutical Association;
5. pass an exam, sat in Bermuda in approximately the 3rd week of the 1 month supervised experience. (The exam tests the candidate's knowledge of pharmacology, commonly encountered calculations, sigs, local laws which are based on British pharmaceutical law and idiosyncrasies of local practice. The candidate will learn the latter two during the 3 weeks before the exam. There are no past papers to study. The exam is 3 hours in length and in the past, approximately 90% have been successful on the first attempt);
