## **REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION IN JERSEY**

A pharmacist registered in Great Britain can register in Jersey in accordance with the Pharmacy, Poisons and Medicines (Jersey) Law. The Registration of Pharmacists in Jersey is the responsibility of the Judicial Greffe, a government organization responsible for providing administrative and secretarial support to Jersey's Courts.

It is normal practice for the pharmacy providing employment to the applicant to outline the details and start date of employment and submit a registration fee of £100 to the Judicial Greffe.

The applicant themselves will then be required to provide to the Judicial Greffe evidence of registration with the RPSGB, certificates of qualifications that led to the registration and a authenticated certificate of good character.

All of the details above can be confirmed through a letter of good standing issued by the Society direct to the Judicial Greffe in Jersey, for further details of a letter of good standing please follow.
