## **REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION IN NIGERIA**

In order to register to work as a Pharmacist in Nigeria applicants must possess a degree in pharmacy from a Pharmacy Council of Nigeria (PCN) approved institution and have passed the Foreign Trained Pharmacists Orientation programme designed by the PCN.

Assuming that the application to begin registration is successful applicants will be required to undertake on years supervised practice. At the end of which, after the supply of relevant documentation to the Director of Pharmaceutical Services, the applicant will become fully registered.
