REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION IN SOUTH AFRICA

All first time applicants seeking registration in South Africa will be required to undertake 1 years 'remunerated pharmaceutical community service in a public sector institution'. Before applying to the South African Pharmacy Council for Registration applicants must first contact The Department of Health to ensure they can be placed in community service once there Registration is complete. Once the community service place has been confirmed applicants will be asked to submit relevant documents to an Examination and Adjudication Committee for approval. When approval has been granted applicants will be required to pass a professional examination and a pre-registration evaluation, if these are passed then a after the payment of Registration fees the applicant will be able to start work as a community service pharmacist

It is worth noting that the SA Department of Health has stated that posts for community service will only be allocated to persons who are not South African Citizens under certain circumstances.
