REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION IN SINGAPORE

All overseas applicants will be required to submit evidence of; completion of pre-registration training, registration in country of study, certificate of good standing from country of study and a CV. Every overseas applicant will also be asked to submit evidence of a job offer with an institution or company in Singapore. The Singapore pharmacy Board will not consider any application for registration where there is no job offer.

Each applicant will be asked to undertake a period of Pre-Registration training, the minimum length of this training is three months. Once training is completed applicants must pass an examination relating to Pharmacy Law in Singapore, this exam can only be sat at locations across Singapore.

Fees for the process are likely to total approximately S\$580 (£192), including Pre-Reg fee, exam fee and registration fee.
