## **REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION IN TANZANIA**

In order to practise as a pharmacist in Tanzania you must register with the Pharmacy Council which is part of the United republic of Tanzania's Ministry of Health and Social Welfare. In summary, they require each applicant to:

1. Hold a pharmacy degree recognised by the Council as being equivalent to a pharmacy degree offered in Tanzania
2. Undertake an internship program covering twelve months practice in a recognised facility in Tanzania.
3. Sit and pass a forensic pharmacy examination.
4. Submit a letter of good standing from the registering body in the applicants country confirming there professional conduct renders them fit to be registered as a pharmacist.
