## **REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION IN THE UNITED ARAB EMIRATES**

To register to work within the UAE pharmacists will need to apply to the Ministry of Health for licensure. In order to gain licence to practice pharmacy applicants will be required to complete three stages of examinations.

1. Arabic Language Exam – fluency in Arabic is mandatory for licensure, applicants will be required to prove they can translate medical terminology from both Arabic to English and English to Arabic
2. Pharmacy Exam – Questions will cover broadly most areas of pharmacy, clinical, pharmacology, therapeutics, pharmacy calculations, over the counter medicines and patient counselling.
3. UAE Pharmacy Regulation Exam – a multiple choice exam based on UAE federal pharmacy law and the UAE code of conduct for pharmacists.
