

There follows the outcome of recent Inquiries heard before the Statutory Committee of the Royal Pharmaceutical Society of Great Britain.

Monday 18, Tuesday 19, Wednesday 20 and Thursday 21 July 2005:

1. In the Restoration Application for Mr [Dilip Patel](#) (Registration No 73918) the Committee decided that at this time his name shall not be restored to the Register.
2. In the Delivery of Determination for Mr [Alan Roch](#) (Registration No 67574) and [Honeysgreen Pharmacy Limited](#) (Identification No 1088653) the Committee resolved to direct the Registrar to remove Mr Roch's name from the Register of Pharmaceutical Chemists. Under Section 11 of the Pharmacy Act 1954, this direction is not to take effect until the expiration of a period of three months from the date on which notice of removal is given or in a case where an appeal has been brought against the direction, until the appeal is determined or withdrawn. The Committee decided to take no further action regarding Honeysgreen Pharmacy Limited.
3. In the New Inquiry into Mr [John Gilpin](#) (Registration No 1055670) the Committee resolved to direct the Registrar to remove Mr Gilpin's name from the Register of Pharmaceutical Chemists. Under Section 11 of the Pharmacy Act 1954, this direction is not to take effect until the expiration of a period of three months from the date on which notice of removal is given or in a case where an appeal has been brought against the direction, until the appeal is determined or withdrawn.
4. In the New Inquiry into Mr **Malcolm Bernard Dexter** (Registration No 66371) the Committee resolved to direct the Registrar to remove Mr Dexter's name from the Register of Pharmaceutical Chemists. Under Section 11 of the Pharmacy Act 1954, this direction is not to take effect until the expiration of a period of three months from the date on which notice of removal is given or in a case where an appeal has been brought against the direction, until the appeal is determined or withdrawn.
5. In the New Inquiry into Mr **James Newman** (Registration No 1072633) the Committee decided to issue Mr Newman with an admonition.
6. In the Resumed Inquiry into Mr [Peter Herman](#) (Registration No 63167) the Committee decided to issue Mr Herman with a reprimand.
7. In the New Inquiry into Mr [Shariff Obadi](#) (Registration No 89030) the Committee resolved to direct the Registrar to remove Mr Obadi's name from the Register of Pharmaceutical Chemists. Under Section 11 of the Pharmacy Act 1954, this direction is not to take effect until the expiration of a period of three months from the date on which notice of removal is given or in a case where an appeal has been brought against the direction, until the appeal is determined or withdrawn.
8. In the Resumed Inquiry into Mr **David Beldon** (Registration No 62802) the Committee resolved to direct the Registrar to remove Mr Beldon's name from the Register of Pharmaceutical Chemists. Under Section 11 of the Pharmacy Act 1954, this direction is not to take effect until the expiration of a period of three months from the date on which notice of removal is given or in a case where an appeal has been brought against the direction, until the appeal is determined or withdrawn.
