

There follows the outcome of recent Inquiries heard before the Statutory Committee of the Royal Pharmaceutical Society of Great Britain.

Monday 12, Tuesday 13, Wednesday 14 and Thursday 15 December 2005:

1. The new Inquiry into Mr Derek Michael Phillips (Registration no. 75766) was adjourned to a future date.
2. In the resumed Inquiry into [Miss Navjot Kaur Manku](#) (Registration no. 1053064) the Committee resolved to issue Miss Manku with a reprimand.
3. In the new Inquiry into [Mr Harwinder Singh Doal](#) (Registration no. 3000717) the Committee resolved to direct the Registrar to remove Mr Doal's name from the Register of Pharmaceutical Chemists. Under Section 11 of the Pharmacy Act 1954, this direction is not to take effect until the expiration of a period of three months from the date on which notice of removal is given or in a case where an appeal has been brought against the direction, until the appeal is determined or withdrawn.
4. The new Inquiry into Mr John Joseph George Barnes (Registration no. 62087) was adjourned for a period of three months.
