

Statutory Committee Inquiries

The Statutory Committee will meet at the Royal Pharmaceutical Society of Great Britain, 1 Lambeth High Street, London SE1, at 9.30am on Monday 20, Tuesday 21, Wednesday 22 and Thursday 23 March 2006 to hear the following inquiries:

Monday 20 March 2006

1. The Committee will resume the Inquiry into a complaint by the Council of the Society against [Mr John Brian Price](#) (Registration no. 54597) which alleges that a failure to provide the best possible healthcare to a patient; a failure to adhere to accepted standards of professional conduct and engaging in behaviour likely to undermine public confidence in the profession; and the use of a SCENAR device despite having no training or accreditation in the use of complementary therapies for the treatment of facial infections, may amount to misconduct.
2. The Committee will resume the Inquiry into a complaint by the Council of the Society against [Ms Maria Mariscal Navarro](#) (Registration no. 1078456) and [Mr Andrew Murdock](#) (Registration no. 73499) which alleges that a labelling error and failure to deal appropriately with a complaint concerning the error, may amount to misconduct.

Tuesday 21 March 2006

2. An Inquiry into a complaint by the Council of the Society against [Mr Michael Turner](#) (Registration no. 67819) which alleges that the unlawful possession of controlled drugs; the possession of quantities of Prescription only Medicines at his home; a failure to make entries in the Controlled Drugs Register in respect of Methadone and Amphetamine purchases and supplies; the unlawful supplies of Methadone and/or Diazepam; and providing false information to police officers, may amount to misconduct. The Committee will also consider convictions for various driving offences; two counts of the supply of class A controlled drugs contrary to section 4(1) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971; three counts of the supply of Class C controlled drugs contrary to section 4(1) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971; and one count of possession of a Class B controlled drug contrary to section 5 (3) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971.

Wednesday 22 March 2006

3. The Committee will deliver the determination of the Inquiry into a complaint by the Council of the Society against [Mrs Maysa Jibreel Al-Natsheh](#) (Registration no. 90768) and [Preston Park Chemists Ltd](#) (Identification no. 1087052) which alleged that a failure to ensure that the pharmacist in charge had the requisite knowledge, skills and fitness to perform the work delegated to him; a failure to ensure that he was sufficiently competent in English; a failure to ensure that he was properly informed of the professional duties he was expected to undertake; a failure to supervise and support the pharmacist in charge; and a failure to exercise proper control over the business, may have amounted to misconduct.
4. The Committee will resume the Inquiry a complaint by the Council of the Society against [Mr Derek Michael Phillips](#) (Registration no. 75766) which alleges that discrepancies in Viagra 50mg and 100mg stock; breaches of Regulation 19 of the Misuse of Drugs Regulations; breaches of the Misuse of

Drugs Safe Custody Regulations; a failure to deal appropriately with Controlled Drugs (failure to segregate patient returns and date-expired stock); the supply of Sildenafil without a valid prescription; breaches of Regulation 6 of the Medicines Sale and Supply Miscellaneous Provisions Regulations 1980; and the condition of the pharmacy notwithstanding a warning from the Society Inspector, may amount to misconduct.

Thursday 23 March 2006

5. The Committee will resume the Inquiry into a complaint by the Council of the Society against [Mr John Joseph George Barnes](#) (Registration no. 62087) which alleges that a dispensing error; a failure to contact the prescriber for clarification; the dismissive response to the error; a failure to keep an accurate record in the patient medication record; and, a failure to record the error, may amount to misconduct.
