Scottish Pharmacy Board Action Plan 2008

Purpose

To review and agree the objectives of the Scottish Pharmacy Board Action Plan 2008.

Strategic objective domain

- Recognised as world influencing and world class.
- Influencing the development of pharmacists to play an expanding and more inclusive part in healthcare, public health and social care.
- Members are engaged with the Society's vision.
- The public recognise pharmacists as the approachable expert in medicines.
- An organisation that consistently demonstrates leadership as a professional body, regulator and publisher.

Action required

The Board is asked to review the proposed objectives against the agreed actions discussed at the Board meeting in January 2008. The Board is also asked to consider using these objectives in Board meeting papers as the associated Strategic Objective Domain to an item.

1. Background

At the Scottish Pharmacy Board meeting in January the Board felt that the overarching strategic objectives contained within the Business Plan were not reflective of the work of the Board or compatible to their remit. They also agreed that the title Business Plan was not appropriate since there was no reference to budgets within the plan.

Appendix 1 shows the SPB Action Plan with the draft objectives and agreed actions.

2. Risk Implications

If the Board does not agree an Action Plan there is a risk of failing to deliver its remit.

3. Resource Implications

The budget has been allocated for this year based on the objectives and actions discussed at the Scottish Pharmacy Board strategy discussion day in November 2007.
