## **Scottish Pharmacy Board Action Plan 2008**

### **Purpose**

To review progress made on the actions of the Scottish Pharmacy Board Action Plan 2008.

### **Strategic objective domain**

- Provide strategic leadership and support for pharmacy practice in Scotland.
- Assist the development of Council policy and implementation in Scotland and develop and implement policy specific to Scotland.
- Promote the science and practice of pharmacy and its contribution to health.
- Provide professional advice to government and its agencies, NHS bodies and other health and social care organisations in Scotland.
- Support the Society's branches in Scotland.
- Support pharmacists in their professional roles in Scotland.

### **Action required**

The Board is asked to review the progress made against the agreed actions in the Action Plan 2008.

### **1. Background**

At the Board meeting in June the Board reviewed the current actions and discussed future actions against the overarching strategic objectives.

At this meeting the Board members requested that they see the progress made on the actions detailed at the next meeting.
