## **Annual Report 2008/2009**

### **Purpose**

### **1. Background**

Last year the Board decided to produce an Annual Report covering the latter half of 2007 and the first half of 2008. Responsibility for the drafting of this report was delegated to the CWG with the final sign off coming from the Board.

The Board is being asked to consider the draft format for the production of the Annual Report covering the latter half of 2008 and the first half of 2009.

- Message from the Chair – A year of change including reflection of the past year and looking to the future – future professional leadership body.
- Coverage of 2008 – 2009:
  - Party Political Conferences
  - Survey Panels
  - MSP / MP activity
  - Parliament Exhibition & Reception
  - Virtual Network
  - Pre-registration ceremony
  - Consultations – e.g. inclusive profession – pharmacy technicians
  - Rx Factor – Laura Wilson
  - Roadshows
  - Boards' Session at BPC

Grouping activities into themes, e.g. Communicating with members, Working with branches, Political influence and Public Affairs, etc., reflective of the past however optimistic for the future, e.g. LPFs.

- Input from Board members (including David Thomson & Kay Blair) - could be reflection of the previous years expressing optimism about the future. Also needs to include Professor Christine Bond & Professor George Downie.
- Branches – ask Branch Secretaries to contribute a review of their activities – suggest a set of questions.
